## Issues We're Tackling

### Barriers to Employment

**Poor Employment Participation Rate of People with Disabilities**

The employment participation rate in Australia for people with disabilities is only 53.4%. Unemployment is a major reason for poverty.

**Our Impact** + -

- Delivered **45,615** hours of employability skills for **2,379** participants most likely to experience barriers to employment to improve job prospects.
- Applied Social impact discounts totalling **\$36,593** allowing disadvantaged communities to access technology.

### High Local Unemployment

**High Unemployment in Hume Local Government Area**

Unemployment in Hume City is 3.4% higher than the Australian average. Poverty is a major cause of housing stress and homelessness.

**Our Impact** + -

- Created **33,359** hours of full award wage work and **40 Employment pathway** outcomes; 4 referrals to further training, 21 casual and 15 part-time employment outcomes through Enable's enterprise trade, supporting local disadvantaged groups and economic development across Melbourne's north.

### Circular Tech

**Australian E-waste is predicted to grow by 30% by 2030**

Zero waste strategies use less new, raw materials and divert waste from landfill.

**Our Impact** + -

- Diverted over **512** tonnes of decommissioned technology from landfill for reuse and recycling (as a last resort).
- Distributed **1,496** refurbished, affordable devices to communities in need.
- Engaged **336** Social and Sustainable Procurement Customers from Government Corporate, business and non-for-profit sectors.

### Connecting Communities

We build resilience in local communities by creating a platform for social and digital inclusion to support and engage disadvantaged local groups.

**Our Impact** + -

- We collaborate with **104+** community partner outlets and enable **14,726** general public volunteering hours to support connected communities.
- Our Social Procurement spend has contributed **\$33,806** to support fellow enterprises.
